



Stefanos Koundouras is Associate Professor of Viticulture in the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), Greece. He graduated from the School of Agriculture of AUTH and he also holds an Oenologist Diploma (DNO), MSc and PhD in Viticulture from the University of Bordeaux (France). He joined the University after 4 years in the private sector as both enologist and viticulturist. He has published over 80 articles in scientific journals and congress proceedings.
